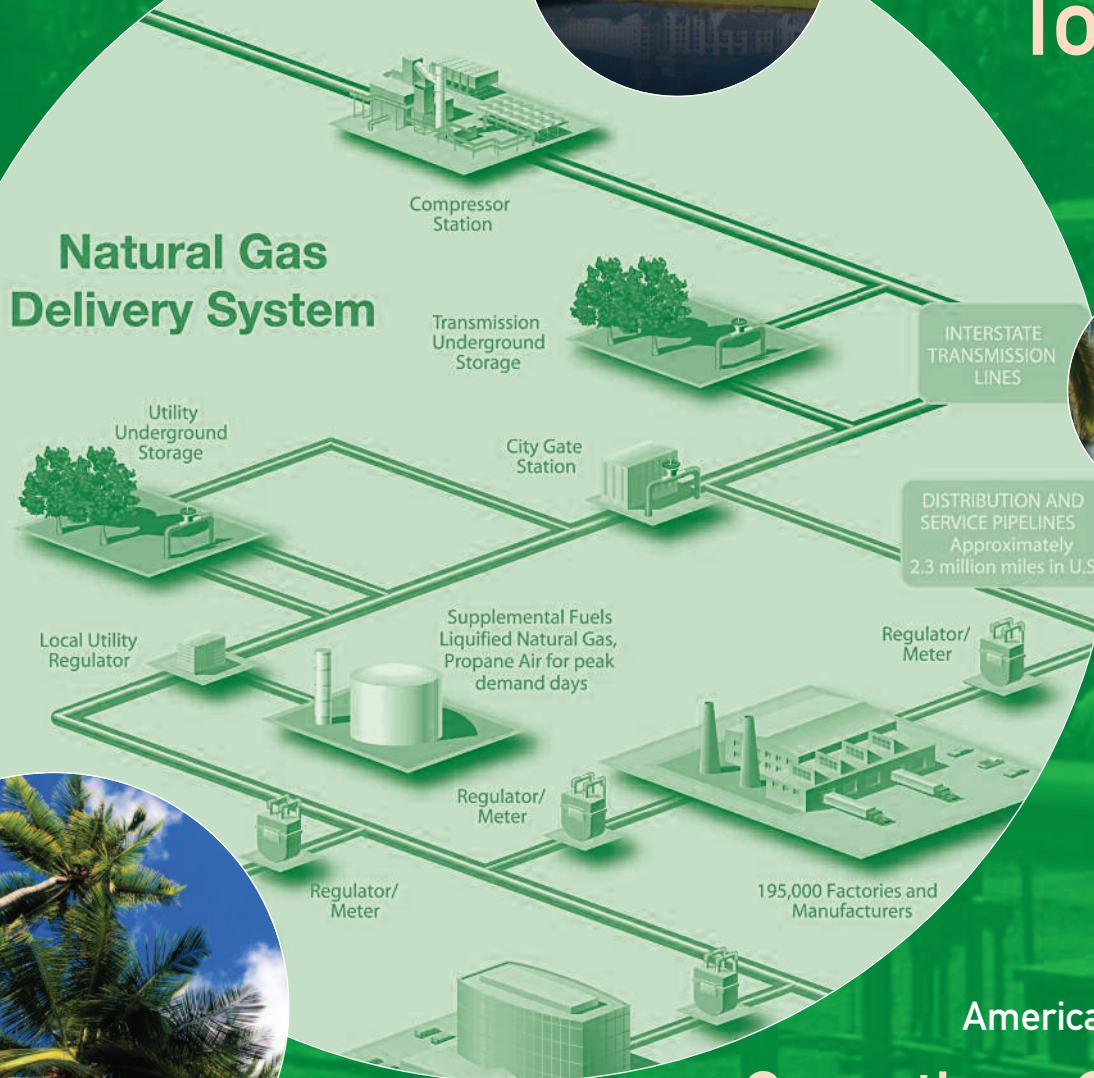

The location of hosted food service/lounge areas to be interspersed and/or confirmed.

Companies who requested and are assigned an "endcap" or "peninsula" (open on 3 sides) are reminded that the backwall which is also the siderall of a neighboring exhibitor may be 8" in height only in the middle 10' of the backwall then the display must be no more than approximately 4" in height on the outside 4' on both sides of the backwall. The latter configuration will afford visibility for a neighboring exhibitor whose siderall is the backwall of an "endcap" or "peninsula".
